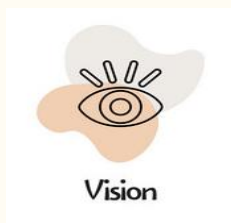

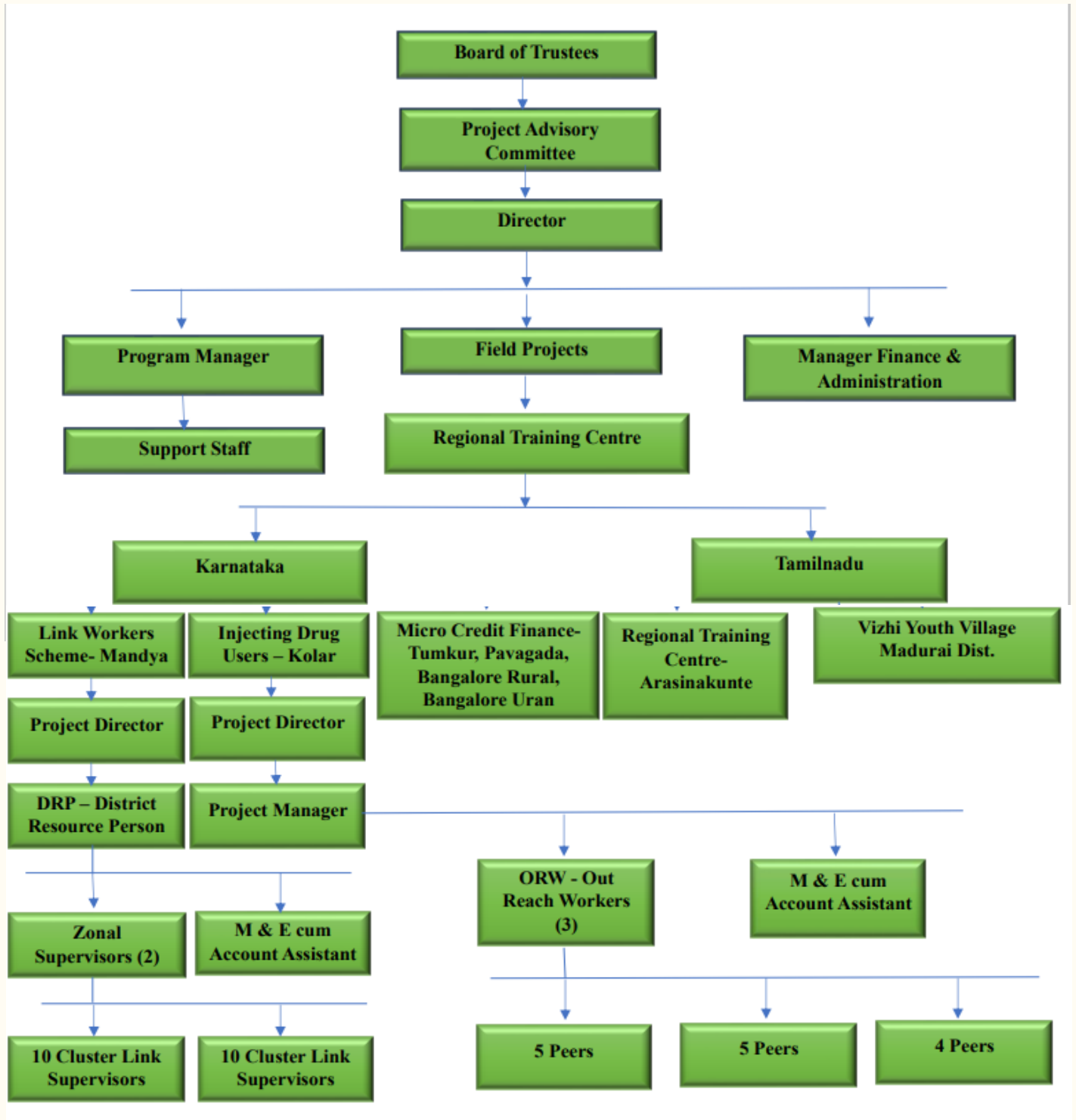

## PROJECT PROGRAMME ACTIVITIES

### **LWS:**

Link Workers Scheme (LWS) in Mandya District supported by KSAPS. This is an ongoing continuing project since 2017 and based on the evaluation outcome / performance, the contract is being renewed every year.

### **IDU:**

Injecting Drug Users Targeted Intervention/ We Care (IDU-TI) programme in Kolar District. This is an on-going project from 2011. Every year the contract agreement is renewed based on annual performance evaluation by NACO / KSAPS. It is being supported by KSAPS.

### **ICICI:**

Micro-finance support to Self Help Groups with the credit support under bank linkage development from ICICI Bank. This is also a continuing programme. In this programme IYD's role is that of a business correspondent.

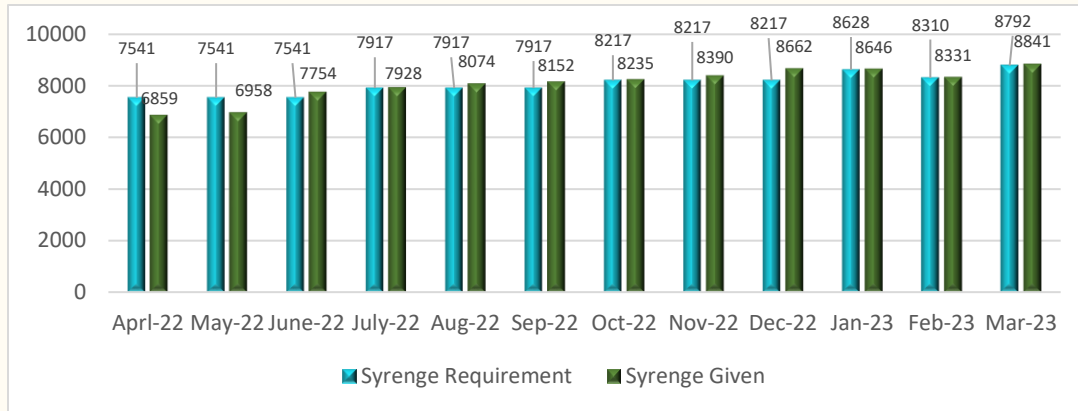

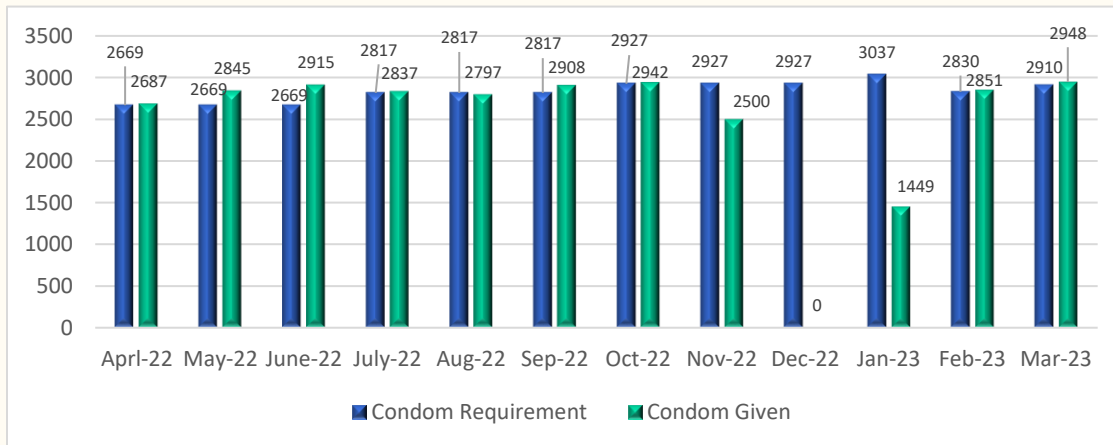

During this period for 105 SHGs, BC Letters were given to 93 groups (1137 members) selected for loan disbursement and distributed Rs. 5,88,79,000 /-. 3.8 % being the delinquency.

The self-help groups use the Micro credit loans broadly for the following purposes such as cow and sheep rearing; small business and petty shops; flower and artificial garland; beep keeping; mobile catering, saree weaving and handlooms.

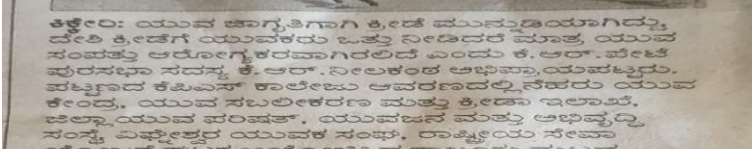
